Director: Pinaki Chaudhuri

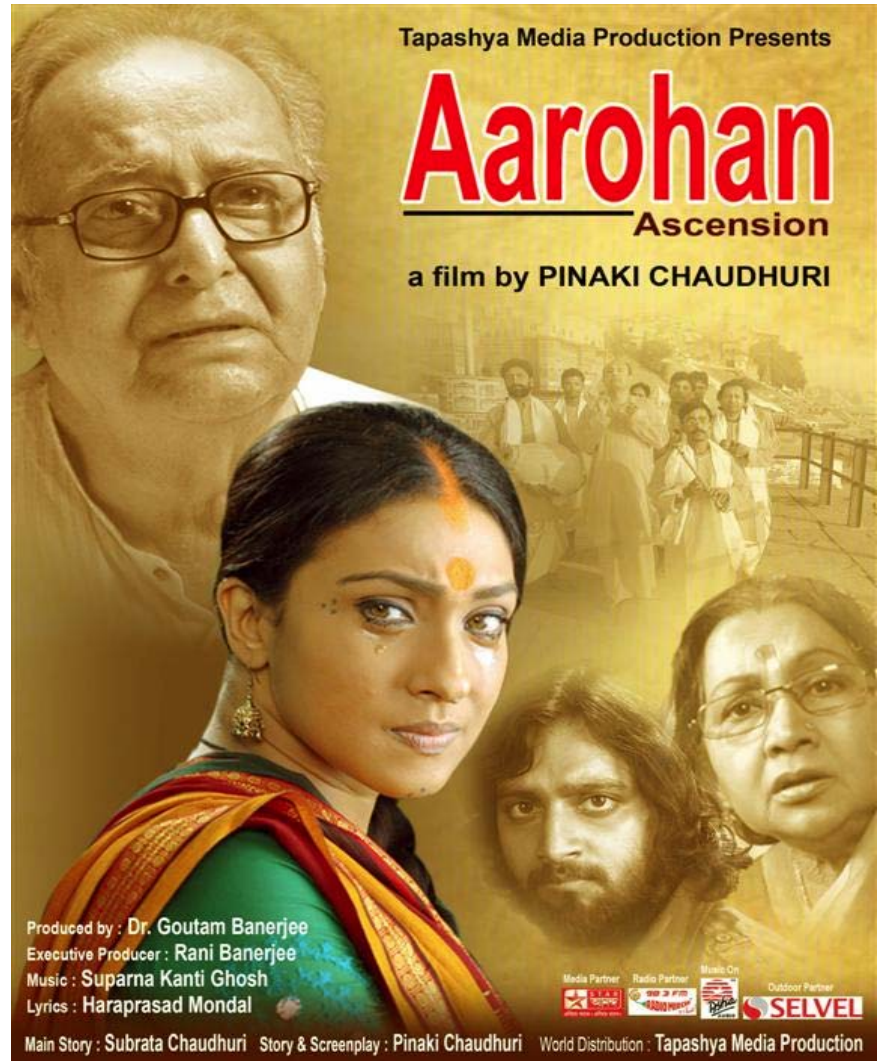
