Driving / Transit help: TTC: Option 1: Take the Bloor subway to Dundas West Station, then either walk south or take the 504 King streetcars to Howard Park Avenue. Option 2: Take the 505 Dundas streetcars to Howard Park Avenue and walk one block west. Option 3: Take the 506 College streetcars to Roncesvalles Avenue. By car: Option 1: From the QEW: Get off at Jameson, turn left at King Street, and follow King until it turns into Roncesvalles. Option 2: From Lakeshore Boulevard: exit at Parkside, and follow Parkside to Howard Park Avenue. Follow Howard Park to Roncesvalles Ave.
